### Course mission

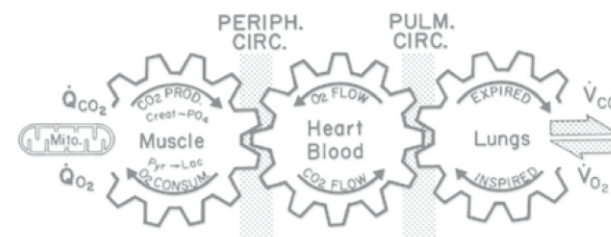
